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1. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
2. On being pointed out that essentially this petition raises certain service related issues of the members of the petitioner-association and therefore in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *L. Chandrakumar vs. Union of India & Ors* reported in (1997) 3 SCC 261, the grievance of the petitioner has to be taken up with the Central Administrative Tribunal, learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with the liberty to the petitioner and its members as well, to take recourse to any other legal remedy, which may be available to them under law, including the



remedy of invoking the relevant provisions of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 before the Central Administrative Tribunal.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
