**ORDER
09.05.2025**

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1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking directions against the respondents to pay compensation arising out of the death of deceased son of the petitioners, who died due to electrocution.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents draw the attention of this Court to *Annexure P-3* of the present petition, where a statement has been recorded under Section 161 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973, wherein, it is stated that the unauthorized connection of electricity was taken from a toilet complex maintained by the Delhi Urban Shelter Improvement Board ("DUSIB"), Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi



("GNCTD").

3. The said body is not even made a party and no averments have been made against the said body.

4. At this stage, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that she may be granted liberty to withdraw the present writ petition, with liberty to file a fresh petition, with correct particulars.

5. Accordingly, the present writ petition, along with the pending application, is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as aforesaid.
