% **ORDER**

1. This petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of order dated 13th September 2024 passed by this Court in **W.P.(C)12872/2024**, where the following directions were passed:

2. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the present, the petitioner would be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to consider the petitioner's case in the light of this Court's decision dated 01.04.2019 in WP(C) No. 4448/2016 titled as "*Vijayan V V vs. Union of India & Ors.*".

3. Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection to this limited request.

4. The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of by directing the respondents to treat the present petition as a representation and dispose of



the same by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of twelve weeks.

5. Needless to state, since this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the petitioner's claims, in case, the petitioner is aggrieved by any order passed by the respondents, it will be open for him to seek legal redressal as permissible in law.

2. Counsel for respondent is present on advance notice. *Mr. Dinesh Murmu (DIG Staff)*, BSF, is also present in Court and fairly states that the representation is already under process (*at final stages*) and a speaking order will be issued within a period of four weeks. On his undertaking, the petition is being disposed of.

3. Liberty is given to petitioner to revive the contempt petition; in case the infraction continues.
