1. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the respondents have issued orders granting notional promotion to the petitioners, *albeit* without the consequential benefits. If that is the case, we leave it open to the petitioners to make a representation to the respondents for grant of the same.

2. The respondents shall consider and decide on the said representation, on its own merits, remaining uninfluenced by the Impugned Order passed by the learned Central Administrative



Tribunal within a period of six weeks of the receipt of the representation.

3. If the petitioner is aggrieved of the decision, it shall be open to the petitioner to challenge the same in accordance with law.
4. The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
