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1. Matter has been taken on the basis of *Office-Note*.
2. It is a disposed of matter.
3. Lastly, when the matter was taken up on 12.08.2025, learned Trial Court was granted additional time to conclude the trial.
4. However, another communication has now been received from learned Trial Court and as per such communication dated 06.04.2026 sent by the concerned learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, there is request for grant of extension of time of four months.
