ORDER

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1. Petitioner had filed a petition seeking divorce.
2. When the abovesaid petition was taken up by the learned Judge, Family Court on 11.09.2024, noticing that the petitioner was in arrears of maintenance and such arrears, which were to the tune of Rs.37 lacs, had not been cleared, the petition was adjourned *sine die*. Thereafter the petitioner, having received some respite from this Court and also from the Hon'ble Supreme Court, moved an application seeking revival of his abovesaid petition.
3. The grievance in the present petition is merely limited to the effect that such application has yet not been decided and the learned Judge, Family Court may be requested to consider and dispose of abovesaid application as expeditiously as possible.
4. The order dated 01.05.2025 passed by learned Judge, Family



Court would indicate that the matter is now fixed up for consideration of the abovesaid application on 03.09.2025.

5. This Court expects that on said date, the abovesaid application is considered, after giving due opportunity of hearing to both the sides.
6. No further direction is warranted in the present matter.
7. The petition stands disposed of in aforesaid terms.
8. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
