This is an application filed under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 on behalf of decree holder Nos. 6 and 7 seeking directions to the Registrar General, Delhi High Court to accept the stamp paper for the value of Rs.1,21,34,000/- for the stamping of the final partition decree dated 19.12.2017 passed in CS(OS)/3014/2011 at the market value of the suit property at Rs.91,00,00,000/-.
