1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. Application stands disposed of.

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3. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking following relief:

a) Writ of Mandamus or any other Appropriate Writ directing the Respondent No. 1 University to refund the UGC-NET fellowship recovered from Petitioner for non-overlapping period; and/or

4. Mr. Gorang Goyal, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance of the petitioner is in respect of the non-release of non-NET Fellowship for non-overlapping period.
5. Mr. Vasanth Rajasekaran, the learned Sr. Standing Counsel for the respondent no.1/JNU at the outset submits that the present writ petition can



be disposed of with a direction to the respondent no.1/JNU to consider the case of the petitioner.

6. Mr. Goyal, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not have any objection in case such a direction is passed making it time bound.

7. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent no.1/university to consider the case of the petitioner for release of money, in case the petitioner is found entitled to the same, within a period of four weeks.

8. The petitioner is also directed to appear before the Students and Project Section (S&P) on 21.05.2025 for the purpose of reconciliation.

9. With the aforesaid directions, the petition stands disposed of.
