1. This petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of order dated 01st July 2024 in **CM(M) 2812/2024**, wherein directions were given for the Trial Court to dispose of application under Order XII Rule 6 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ('**CPC**') within three months.
2. Counsel for petitioner states that this has still not done and the matter is getting pushed.
3. It has been noted from the order-sheets that arguments had been heard on the application under Order XII Rule 6 CPC and the matter had been placed for orders.
4. The Trial Court is, therefore, directed to pass orders on the application



within the next 6 weeks.

5. The petition is, therefore, disposed of with aforesaid directions.

6. The Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter or any observations on the assertion which have been made by the petitioner in this petition.

7. It has also been noted that petitioner himself has been seeking adjournments before the Trial Court which also potentially necessitated a delay in the decision.
