ORDER

1. This petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioner under Section 29A (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ('1996 Act') seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal.
2. It is stated in the petition that the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal has been extended from time to time by this Court and lastly upto 31.04.2025 vide order dated 31.01.2025 in O.M.P.(MISC.)(COMM.) 96/2025 and that only the arbitral award remains to be pronounced. Extension of the mandate is sought upto 30.06.2025 to enable the Arbitral Tribunal to pass the award.
3. Issue notice.
