3. This petition is preferred on behalf of the Petitioner under Section 29A (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ('1996 Act') seeking extension of the mandate of the learned Arbitrator.
4. It is stated in the petition that evidence was concluded on 24.04.2024. Vide order dated 01.08.2024, learned Arbitrator extended the mandate by six months with the consent of the parties whereafter final arguments were heard on 27.03.2025 and award was reserved. Extension of the mandate of learned Arbitrator is sought by 03 months to enable the learned Arbitrator to pass and publish the award.
