C. HARI SHANKAR, J.

1. The only prayer of the petitioner in this writ petition is for a direction to the respondents to decide the appeal preferred by the petitioner under Section 117(2) of the Border Security Force Act, 1968¹.

2. Mr. Anshuman Singh, learned Senior Panel Counsel for the respondents undertakes on instructions that the petitioner's appeal would be disposed of within a period four weeks. The respondents shall remain bound by the said statement.

3. Accordingly, we dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the respondents to dispose of the petitioner's appeal preferred under
