1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. Application stands disposed of.

This petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioner under Section 9 of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ('1996 Act') *inter alia* restraining the Respondents from encashing Performance Bank Guarantee bearing No. 07211GP241044426 dated 28.03.224 for a sum of Rs. 2,16,22,950/-.
