This petition is filed by the Petitioner under Section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ('1996 Act') seeking restraint order against the Respondents from assigning, transferring, selling, dealing with or disposing in any manner all or any part of the pledged securities and/or creating or attempting to create or permit to create any security or interest of any kind in favour of any other person as also restraining from acting in pursuance of the Advertisement dated 01.08.2023.

5. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of as withdrawn. Needless to state that the Petitioner will be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate remedies in case of any further or fresh cause of action.
