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1. The petitioner challenges the order dated 15.05.2025 (hereafter '**the impugned order**'), passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-03 ('**ASJ**'), South, Saket Courts, New Delhi in a revision petition filed by Respondent No. 2, challenging the order dated 13.05.2025, passed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate ('**CJM**'), South, Saket Courts, New Delhi directing registration of FIR.

2. The learned Additional Sessions Judge by impugned order while issuing notice to the petitioner, has listed the matter for consideration on 24.05.2025 and has stayed the order dated

13.05.2025, passed by the learned CJM.
