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1. This petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioner under Section 29A (4) and (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ('1996 Act') seeking extension of the mandate of the learned Arbitrator.
2. Disputes having arisen between the parties, in a pending appeal before this Court being FAO (COMM) 50/2022, vide order dated 25.04.2023, the Division Bench appointed a Sole Arbitrator to adjudicate the disputes, with the consent of the parties.
