1. Allowed subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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3. This is a petition filed under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a period of three months for making and publishing the Award.
4. It is stated that the arguments have already been concluded.
5. Issue notice.
6. Ms. Gupta, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and has no objection to the petition being allowed.
