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1. The present petitions under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (formerly Section 482 Cr.P.C.) seek quashing of separate orders dated 22nd May, 2025 passed by the Additional Sessions



Judge-02, North-West District, Rohini Courts, whereby the regular bail granted to the Petitioners vide separate orders dated 24th March, 2025 was cancelled, and coercive steps were directed to be taken against them in connection with FIR No. 521/2023 registered at P.S. Shalimar Bagh, under Sections 420/406/34 IPC.
