ORDER

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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeks the following prayers:-

“a) Issue an appropriate order, direction or Writ (e.g. , of Mandamus) directing the concerned Trial Court of Ms. Surbhi, Ld. JMFC (Mahila Court), Dwarka Courts, District South-West Delhi, New Delhi, in case MC No. 656/2013 (New No. 462/2016) – to expeditiously conclude the pending proceedings within a fixed time frame as determined by this Hon’ble Court (for instance, within 2 months from the date of order);
b) Pass any further order(s) which this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interests of justice.”

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the complaint filed by respondent no.2 under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 (for short, ‘DV Act, 2005’) has



been pending before the concerned learned Trial Court since 2013.

4. In view of the same, the present petition is disposed of with a request to the learned Trial Court to ensure that the proceedings in the present complaint are completed as expeditiously as possible without giving undue adjournment to either of the parties.

5. The petition stands disposed of.

6. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.

7. Copy of the order be sent to the concerned learned Trial Court for necessary information and compliance.
