1. Written submissions are taken on record.
2. It is not in dispute that this case is amenable to jurisdiction by the Armed Forces Tribunal¹. In similar matters, we have transferred the proceedings to the AFT in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in *L Chandra Kumar v. UOI*². One such order has been handed over, across the Bar, by Ms. Avshreya Pratap Singh Rudy, learned CGSC for the respondents which is of 4 December 2025 in WP(C) 6300/2021³.
