3. By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR bearing No. 396/2024, dated 26.05.2024, registered at Police Station Mukherjee Nagar, Delhi under Section 509/506/354-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (hereafter 'IPC').
4. The concerned Investigating Officer (IO) states that she has not taken any steps after registration of the FIR, as the complainant has not been co-operating with her in the investigation. In fact, the complainant has given in writing that she does not want to proceed with the case. The complainant is present through video conferencing. It is not appropriate to deal with cases



under Sections 376/506/508 of the IPC through video conferencing.

5. At this stage, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition, without prejudice to his rights and contentions on the ground that no compromise deed has been filed on record and the complainant also wants to appear in Court physically.

6. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
