4. These are the petitions seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal for a period 9 months for conclusion of the arbitration proceedings and to render the Arbitral award.

5. The mandate of the arbitral Tribunal has expired on 17.05.2025.

6. Mr. Jain, learned senior counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was in CIRP proceedings, and hence, there was some delay.
