1. The present petition assails a communication no. F. No. 12(62)/2023AEI/PMI Electro Mobility Solution Limited/Violation (26248) dated 05.12.2023, issued by the respondent whereby it declared that the petitioner is non-compliant with the eligibility requirements of phase-II of the Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of Electric Vehicles (**FAME-II**) Scheme and directed (i) that the petitioner should refund the incentives in the amount of INR 280,59,00,687/- that has been availed by the petitioner, and (ii) all claims for incentives filed by the petitioner as on the said date stands cancelled.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent informs that a communication dated 13.01.2025 has been addressed to the petitioner which reads as under:
