3. The Petitioner has filed the present petition, *inter alia*, praying as under:

“a. Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ(s), order(s), direction(s) directing the respondents to expeditiously dispose of, preferably within two weeks, the appeal filed more than almost eight years ago on 23.06.2017 under s. 246A of the Income-tax Act, 1961 for Assessment Year 2011-12;”

4. Clearly, a period of eight years is more than sufficient time for the



Appellate Authority to dispose of the petitioner's appeal.

5. In view of the above, we direct that the appeal preferred by the petitioner be disposed of as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date.

6. If there is any impediment in the disposal of the appeal, the Appellate Authority shall communicate the same to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
