1. As regards the claim of petitioner, the fact remains that Certificate of Vending ('COV') dated 06th November 2021, speaks of him being permitted to vend '*food/snacks with gas cylinder/fire*'.
2. In view of the aforesaid, it must be inferred that petitioner cannot be made to vend in a mobile manner, particularly by using gas cylinder/fire.
3. That being so, the condition to the extent of petitioner, asking him to be a mobile vendor cannot be acted upon, particularly by using gas cylinder/fire.
4. However, we direct respondents to initiate action against petitioner, in case, he violates other terms and conditions of the COV, but for the mobile vending condition.
5. Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.



6. Pending applications, if any, are rendered infructuous.
