% **ORDER**

1. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent nos. 4 and 5 submits that the vehicle in question has been released by respondent nos. 4 and 5 after the petitioner paid all the defaulted instalments.
2. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly states that the vehicle which was seized by the respondent nos. 4 and 5 has been returned. However, he submits that the only surviving controversy is with regard to the claim of compensation/damages.
3. This Court is of the view that the petitioner's prayer for compensation/damages cannot be decided by following summary procedure

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as it would require leading of evidence.

4. Faced with the above situation, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a civil suit to claim compensation/damages from the respondents.

5. The petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
