ORDER

16.04.2025

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1. Counsel for the respondent states that they have now decided on the representation of the petitioner.
2. Counsel for the respondent hands up a status report filed on 26th July 2024, which is, however, not on record.
3. As per the status report, the representation of the petitioner was decided and an order for leave encashment of Rs.6,84,480/- has been issued in petitioner's favour.
4. The petitioner, who appears in person, states that she has received the same, however, is claiming Rs.4,72,291.20/- towards 18% interest due from the month of December 2020 till the month of September 2024.
5. Considering the order of which compliance is sought does not indicate that any interest would be payable, petitioner is at liberty to seek further directions from the Writ Court in this regard.



6. The judgment of which compliance is dated 20th May 2024 in W.P.(C) 7277/2024, where the following directions were passed:

7. Be that as it may, in case the petitioner is entitled to the benefits as applicable under Rule 39C of the CCS (Leave) Rules, 1972, there is no reason why the representation of the petitioner cannot be decided. The only consideration by the respondent would be to ascertain as to whether she is the only widow, apart from ascertaining whether the conditions stipulated in Rule 39C are fulfilled.

8. In that view of the matter, it is directed that the respondents shall decide the representation of the petitioner filed on 07.03.2024 within a period of four weeks from today.

7. The petition is, therefore, disposed of with liberty granted to the petitioner to address her grievance relating to the interest amount, in appropriate proceedings.

8. Status report be placed on record.
