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1. The present Petition has been filed by the Petitioner under Section 115 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ('CPC') seeking to challenge an order dated 12.04.2024 passed by Ld. Civil Judge, Karkardooma Court, Delhi [hereinafter referred to as 'Impugned Order'].
