This is a fresh petition filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of the FIR No. 364/2021 under Section 363/365/506 and 34 Indian Penal Code, 1860 read with Section 84 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 registered at Police Station Najafgarh, Delhi.
4. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition as it is submitted that the arguments on Charge are yet to be addressed and that he shall raise all
