1. This petition has been filed, under Section 29A (4) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of the learned Sole Arbitrator for a period of six months from 30.06.2025.
2. The mandate of the learned Sole Arbitrator was extended from time to time, lastly by order dated 27.11.2024 in O.M.P.(MISC)(COMM.) 830/2024 until 30.06.2025.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner states that presently, the matter is at the stage of Petitioner's rejoinder arguments.
4. He states that the schedule for the conclusion of arguments and directions has already been being fixed, and the last date of hearing is 22.08.2025.
5. He states that the mandate has expired on 30.06.2025 and parties are



requesting for extension of the mandate by a period of six (6) months for completing the arbitral proceedings and making of the arbitral award.
