1. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the parties have since resolved all disputes in the present suit before the DHCMCC and the terms of the settlement arrived at *inter-se* them have also been reduced to writing in the form of a Settlement Agreement dated 30.01.2025, which is forming a part of the record.
2. Learned counsel for the parties make a joint oral prayer before this Court for the passing of a consent decree in terms of the said Settlement Agreement dated 30.01.2025.
3. Learned counsel for the plaintiff further submits that, in view of the settlement arrived at, the plaintiff does not wish to press for any other relief(s) *qua* the defendant.
4. Learned counsel of the parties confirm the terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 30.01.2025 and identify the signatures of their respective clients thereon as well.



5. This Court has perused the terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 30.01.2025 as recorded *inter-se* the plaintiff and the defendant and finds them to be lawful.

6. Accordingly, the present suit is decreed in terms of the settlement arrived at *inter se* the plaintiff and the defendant as recorded in the Settlement Agreement dated 30.01.2025.

7. The Registry is directed to draw up the Decree Sheet.

8. Needless to mention, the Settlement Agreement dated 30.01.2025, shall form a part of the Decree Sheet, and the parties shall remain bound by the terms thereof.

9. In view of the above, the captioned suit, alongwith the pending application(s), stands disposed of.

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10. Learned counsel for the defendant submits that since the parties have settled their disputes amicably, the present counter claim has become infructuous and thus wishes to withdraw the same.

11. In view of the foregoing submission the counter claim is dismissed as withdrawn.
