1. For the grounds and reasons stated in the application, the request is allowed and accordingly, the main petition is taken up on board today itself.
2. Disposed of.

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3. The Applicant is one of the accused in FIR No. 257/2023 dated 31st July, 2023, registered under Sections 323, 326, 341 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860¹ at P.S. Delhi Cantt., Delhi. Since there are other co-accused, the State had objected that partial quashing on the basis of settlement is not permissible in the present case. This Court, in order dated

15th May, 2024, expressly observed that it was not inclined to quash the FIR on the basis of a partial settlement.

4. In light of the above observation, counsel for the Petitioner, on instructions, states that he would like to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to re-file on the basis of a settlement between all the accused and the Complainant.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as aforesaid.

6. The next date of hearing, i.e., 16th October, 2025, stands cancelled.
