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1. The Petitioner, a convict undergoing life imprisonment in proceedings arising from FIR No. 136/2006 registered under Sections 302/307/449/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at P.S. Welcome has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking grant of parole for a period of 60 days.
2. Counsel for the Petitioner states that from 29th July, 2025, new conviction year has commenced and the Petitioner is entitled to be released on furlough as well as parole.
3. In such circumstances the Petitioner is at liberty to file an appropriate application to the concerned Jail authorities within a period of one week from today, which shall then be considered and decided within a period of



10 days thereafter.

4. With the above directions, the present petition is disposed of. All rights and contentions of the parties are left open.
