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I.A. 7293/2025 (under Order XXIII Rule 3, CPC)

1. This is an application under Order XXIII Rule 3 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ('CPC') for recording of compromise between the parties.
2. The application is duly signed by the authorised representatives of the parties and their respective counsel.
3. The terms of the settlement are mentioned in paragraph 3 of the application.
4. I have gone through the terms of the settlement and do not find anything unlawful therein.
5. Counsel for the plaintiff confirms that as per the terms of the settlement, a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- has been paid to the plaintiff by the



defendant.

6. The parties shall remain bound by the terms of the Settlement.

7. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of.

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8. In light of the order passed above, the present suit is decreed in terms of paragraphs 35 (a) and (b) of the plaint.

9. Let the decree sheet be drawn up.

10. Since the matter has been resolved at an initial stage, the Registry is directed to issue a certificate of refund of 100% of the Court Fees in favour of the plaintiff, in terms of Section 16 of the Court Fees Act, 1870.
