1. This application has been filed by the respondent, seeking modification of order dated 16th April 2025, passed by this Court.
2. It is clarified in the said application that break-up of amount, which is payable to petitioner, is as under:

3. That the interim maintenance calculated from 17th August, 2017 till 2nd March, 2020 @ Rs. 66,000/- per month on a

pro-rata basis computes to Rs. 20,17,400/-. Subtracting sums already paid by the Respondent of Rs. 16,43,996/- for the same period – an amount which undisputedly already stands paid -- the balance payable to the Petitioner amounts to Rs. 3,71,204/-. The breakup of the amount is as follows:-



17 th August, 2017 to 31 st August, 2017 [15 days]	Rs. 33,000/-
1 st September, 2017 to 28 th February 2020 [30 months]	Rs. 19,80,000/-
1 st March, 2020	Rs. 2,200/-
Total:-	Rs. 20,15,200/-
Sum already paid:-	Rs. 16,43,996/-
Sum remaining:-	Rs. 3,71,204/-

4. That vide the Order dated 02.03.2020, the interim maintenance amount was reduced to Rs. 33,000/- with consent of the parties and the amount from March, 2020 onwards has regularly been paid as stands admitted by the Petitioner herein.

3. An amount of Rs.3,71,204/- has been remitted to the petitioner. Counsel for petitioner acknowledges the same.

4. As regards monthly payment of Rs.33,000/-, the same is continuing to be paid by respondent.

5. Basis this undertaking by respondent, the application is allowed. Petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner, to approach the Court, in case there is any continued infraction.
