1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India and petitioner, *inter alia*, seeks directions in the nature of *Habeas Corpus* seeking directions for release of appellant from the illegal detention
2. The brief facts of the case are that the Petitioner, aged 22 Years, along with his family, was apprehended from Saharanpur, UP, by the Delhi Police.
