1. In compliance of judgment dated 12th February 2024 passed by the Court in **W.P.(C) 10599/2021** reported as 2024:DHC:1042, counsel for respondent/*Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IIBI)* states that, they have already issued guidelines on 06th August 2024.
