**CONT.CAS(C) 1017/2025**

1. This petition alleges wilful disobedience of order dated 27<sup>th</sup> February 2025, wherein the following directions were passed:

4. In view of the above and when the impugned order is tested on the aforementioned precepts, it becomes apparent that absence of reasons in the original SCN in support of a proposed retrospective cancellation as well as a failure to place the petitioner on prior notice of such an intent clearly invalidates the impugned action. We are thus of the considered opinion that the writ petition is entitled to succeed on this short ground alone.

5. We accordingly allow the writ petition by modifying the impugned order and providing that the cancellation of the petitioner's GST registration shall come into effect from the date of the SCN i.e. 29 October 2024.

6. The stipulation in the impugned order of cancellation to come into effect from 29 October 2023 is consequently quashed.



2. The context of this petition is regarding petitioner's cancellation of GST registration. Pursuant to the said order, a representation was made on 29<sup>th</sup> April 2025, however, the issue has still not been complied with.
3. *Mr. Shashank Sharma*, Standing Counsel for respondent, appears and states on instructions that, there has been some communication gap and this issue will be resolved within the next 2 weeks.
4. On this assurance from counsel for respondent, this petition is disposed of.
5. In the event, there is still lack of compliance, petitioner will be at liberty to revive this petition and proceedings in contempt shall be initiated against the concerned officer.
6. Petition stands disposed.
