3. Status report dated 12.09.2025 authored by Mr. Manish Jain, Executive



Engineer, Building Department, Narela Zone, Municipal Corporation of Delhi
has been placed on record wherein it has been recorded as under:-

- “2. That the Hon’ble Court vide its order dated 30/04/2025 directed the answering respondent to file status report. In this regard it is submitted that complete demolition action was done on 14/12/2023 at the property, during which three shops and a partly demolished shop was completely demolished.
3. That the property lies in the demolished stage at present. No new construction has been found at the property since then. Present photographs of the property are annexed as Annexure-R-1.”
