1. Counsel for the respondent states that if the petitioner appears before the respondent/ New Delhi Municipal Corporation ('**NDMC**'), with the original *challans* for the purpose of verification of their claim, for identification or inclusion in the survey of street vendors, the claim can be dealt with in accordance with law.
2. In such an eventuality, accepting the statement made, to the aforesaid effect, by the counsel for respondent/NDMC, we permit the petitioner to



appear on 11th August 2025 at 11:00 AM. before the *Director (Enforcement)*, NDMC with original *challans* first to verify and establish their claim in support of their prayer for issuance of a vending certificate and/or inclusion in survey.

3. With the aforesaid liberty in favour of petitioner, we deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition.
4. Needless to clarify that it shall be open for petitioner to approach afresh in case a fresh cause to that effect arose.
5. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
