1. This application is filed on behalf of the Judgement Debtors under Section 151 CPC for release of an amount of Rs. 1,99,02,842/- along with accrued interest in favour of the Judgment Debtors during the pendency of this petition.
2. Issue notice.
3. Mr. Aditya Kumar, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the Decree Holder.
4. During the course of hearing, parties have reconciled the accounts and worked out the payments in consonance with the arbitral award dated 12.04.2023, challenge to which has been partially allowed by this Court in O.M.P.(COMM.) 356/2023 *vide* judgement dated 09.07.2025. Court is



informed that neither party has challenged the judgment.

5. As agreed between the parties, it is directed that an amount of Rs.1,97,04,205/- shall be released in favour of the Decree Holder along with up to date accrued interest from the date of deposit of the money in this Court and an amount of Rs.5,56,47,556/- shall be released in favour of the Judgement Debtors with up to date accrued interest from the date of deposit. The monies shall be released within a period of four weeks from today.

6. Before closing the matter, Court appreciates the efforts put in by respective counsels to bring an early closure to the *inter se* disputes between the parties.

7. Application stands disposed of.

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8. This petition stands disposed of in light of the order passed above.

9. Date of 01.12.2025 is cancelled.
