1. The present Criminal Leave Petition under Section 419(4) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner, against the impugned Judgment dated 27.03.2025 of learned JMFC, South-East District, Saket Courts, Delhi in Ct. Case No.586/2019 vide which the Respondent has been acquitted in the Complaint under Section 138 of NI Act.
2. In view of the Judgment of *Celestium Financial vs. A. Gnanasekaran*, 2025 SCC OnLine SC 1320 and Order of this Court in CRL.L.P.215/2021 dated 23.07.2025, the present matter is disposed of with direction that the present Petition be treated as an Appeal under the proviso to Section 372 of CrPC and numbered accordingly.
3. In case there is Application pending for Condonation of Delay, the same be also transferred along with the entire record to be considered by the learned ASJ in accordance with law.

5. The parties are directed to appear before the concerned learned Principal District & Sessions Judge on 20.08.2025.

6. It is hereby, clarified that there are no observations as to the merits of the case. All rights and contentions of the parties are left open to be agitated before the Court concerned.

7. In view of the above, the present Appeal is disposed of along with the pending Application(s), if any.
