ORDER

30.07.2025

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1. Appellant is aggrieved by order dated 08.01.2024 whereby his application seeking injunction has been dismissed.
2. After hearing arguments for some time, learned Senior Counsel for appellant, on instructions, submits that he does not wish to press present appeal. He, however, seeks a direction to learned Trial Court to expedite disposal of suit in question, primarily, for the reason that father of appellant is 90 years old and is under acute trauma and pressure on account of pendency of present suit and criminal complaint filed by his son against the concerned defendants.
3. In view of above, without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, present appeal is dismissed as not pressed. All rights and contentions of parties are left open.

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4. Learned Trial Court is requested to give utmost priority to suit in question and to make best endeavour to dispose it of, as expeditiously as possible and, preferably, within one year from the date it takes up.
5. Needless to say, all parties shall render due assistance and cooperation to learned Trial Court to achieve abovesaid expeditious disposal.
6. Appeal stands disposed of in aforesaid terms.
7. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of in aforesaid terms.
