1. Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.96/2024 of PS Kalkaji for offence under Section 377/498A/406/34 IPC on the ground that complainant *de facto* (respondent no.2) has settled the disputes with the petitioners.
2. Learned ASC accepts notice and submits that State has serious objections to this petition.
3. In paragraphs 9-10 of the FIR, the respondent no.2 has alleged that her husband and mother-in-law did not want her to give birth to a child, so they made her consume certain tablets with milk which caused miscarriage without her consent. That, *prima facie* would be an offence under Section 313 IPC and learned ASC submits that the Investigating Officer needs to continue further investigation to file a chargesheet.
4. Under these circumstances, learned counsel for petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this petition. Accordingly, the petition and pending application are dismissed as withdrawn.
