1. The petitioner is exempted from filing certified copies of Document P-1 to P-12 at this stage.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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3. The present petition has been filed under Section 29-A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (hereinafter, 'Act of 1996') seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal for a period of six (6) months.
4. None appears on behalf of the respondent despite advance notice.
5. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the one year period for rendering the award expired on 28th February, 2025. Subsequently, the parties extended the same by a further period of six months, which is to expire on 28th August, 2025.
