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1. Ms. Supriya Juneja, counsel for the Appellant, states that in light of



the statement made by Mr. Vishal Khanna, counsel for the Respondent, stating that the Respondent, Mr. Sanjay Sachdeva, has deceased, the present proceedings cannot continue under Section 378 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973¹ and the appeals would have to be abated under Section 394 of Cr.P.C as the instant appeal has been filed against an order of acquittal.
