1. Issue notice. Ms. Neetika Sharma, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. She is permitted to file her *vakalatnama* by 08.08.2025.
2. The petitioner seeks directions for the release of his Provident Fund, Gratuity, and other terminal dues, along with issuance of a No Objection Certificate and an Experience Letter.
3. It is the petitioner's case that he was in the services of respondent No.1 – Alliance Air Aviation Limited, from 19.02.2016, and tendered his resignation on 05.03.2021. He claims to have served the requisite notice period of six months, but states that his statutory and contractual dues have not yet been paid.
4. As the petitioner's representation for payment of his dues has not



been responded to, I am of the view that the appropriate course, at this stage, is to direct the respondents to treat the present writ petition as a representation, and take an appropriate decision on the petitioner's claims within a period of six weeks from today. If any amounts or documents sought by the petitioner are admittedly payable or issuable to him, the respondents will take the necessary steps within a further period of four weeks thereafter.

5. In the event the respondents contend that any of the petitioner's claims are unjustified, either in full or part, they will communicate the reasons thereof to the petitioner within a period of six weeks.

6. The writ petition, alongwith pending applications, is accordingly disposed of.

7. All rights and contentions of the parties remain reserved.
