3. Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950 read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (old Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973) has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner, Vipin Kumar Saluja for quashing the Order dated 01.04.2025 rejecting the First Spell of Furlough and for granting Furlough to the Petitioner for 21 days.
4. The Furlough has been denied to the Petitioner *vide* Order dated 17.03.2025 essentially on the ground that he has not earned rewards Annual



Good Conduct Report in the last three years. The record shows that the Parole has been granted to the Applicant vide Orders dated 14.08.2018 and 20.12.2024 by this Court.

5. Considering the conduct and the record, the Petitioner be released on **First spell** of Furlough for a period of **21 days**, on the following terms and conditions:

- i. The Petitioner shall furnish a personal bond in the sum of **Rs.10,000/-** with one surety of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Jail Superintendent.
- ii. The Petitioner shall report to the SHO of the local area once a week on every Sunday between 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM during the period of furlough.
- iii. The Petitioner shall furnish a telephone/mobile number to the Jail Superintendent as well as SHO of local police station, on which he can be contacted, if required. The said telephone number shall be kept active and operational at all the times by the petitioner.
- iv. The Petitioner shall ordinarily reside at the address mentioned in the Petition.
- v. Immediately upon the expiry of period of Furlough, the Petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Superintendent.
- vi. The period of Furlough shall be counted from the day when the Petitioner is released from jail.

6. The Petition stands disposed of.
