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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

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2. The present petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, 1950, seeks following prayers:-

“(i) Set aside the impugned order dated 26/04/2024 passed by Labour Commissioner Ashok Vihar, Delhi in the matter Ramesh Chand Vs Anil Jindal & Anr. bearing no. ECD/113/NW/2021/1084- 88.

(iii) Any other relief(s) which this Hon'ble court may deem fit and proper.”

3. None appears on behalf of the petitioner today.

4. There has been no appearance on behalf of the petitioner on the previous two dates of hearing, i.e., 10.10.2025 and 28.11.2025, before the learned Registrar as well.



5. *Vide* order dated 30.07.2025, this Court had passed the following order:-
