1. This application is filed on behalf of the Petitioner under Section 151 CPC seeking permission to file lengthy synopsis and list of dates.
2. Issue notice.
3. Mr. Raheel Kohli, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the Respondent.
4. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and disposed of.

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5. This petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioner under Section 29A (4) and (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ('1996 Act') seeking extension of the mandate of the learned Arbitral Tribunal by a period of 12 months from 25.08.2025.



6. Disputes having arisen between the parties in relation to Letter of Award dated 23.11.2012 issued in favour of the Petitioner by the Respondent for implementation of IT infrastructure and applications in the jurisdictional area of Uttar Haryana and subsequent management of IT infrastructure/applications, three-member Arbitral Tribunal was constituted to adjudicate the disputes. Mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal was extended for six months with the consent of the parties, initial mandate having expired. It is stated that mandate of the learned Arbitral Tribunal has expired on 15.08.2025 and the arbitral proceedings are at the stage of final arguments of the Respondent.

7. Issue notice.

8. Mr. Raheel Kohli, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the Respondent and fairly, on instructions, does not object to the extension of mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal *albeit* refutes the averments in the petition on the merits of the case.

9. Accordingly, without going into the merits of the case and/or the allegations levelled in the present petition, with the consent of the parties, mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal is extended by a period of 09 months from 16.08.2025.

10. Petition is allowed and disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
